

Millésime 2010

The winter of 2010 was long and harsh, marked by three cold snaps, similar to 2009. Temperatures remained below average until May, causing a slight delay in budburst. Warm weather returned in June, aiding flowering, while a dry summer with ideal ripening conditions followed. Harvesting in perfect weather allowed for optimal phenolic maturity. The 2010 vintage is one of Château Castera's finest, with deep color, complex aromas, and intense fruit, marking it as a flagship year.
