

# Vintage 2016

Announcing two great vintages in a row can seem optimistic, yet 2016 is indeed remarkable for its quality, quantity, and classic style. A very wet spring replenished soil water reserves, helping the vines withstand an exceptionally dry, hot summer. The grapes ripened fully in warm, dry weather with cool nights, producing deeply colored, aromatic grapes with good acidity. Extraction varied by grape variety, with Cabernets showing excellent maturity. Overall, 2016 produced wines with intense color, ripe tannins, and high quality.
