

## Vintage 2017

The mild weather in February and March encouraged early vine growth, but two frost episodes in April destroyed 30-50% of the 2017 Bordeaux crop. May was sunny with quick, even flowering, and June was very hot. July was cloudier, and August was average, followed by early September rains that worried winegrowers. Despite this, the grapes were in good condition overall, with aromatic freshness and moderate polyphenolic potential. The 2017 vintage is delicious and very attractive.
